Our show hosts sit down with the band leaders to talk about the band, what it's like to be a young musician, and about music education opportunities in New Orleans. The students perform for 30 minutes live on the air and Facebook Live, both of which are broadcast worldwide. This is the same studio experience that professional musicians and legends like Irma Thomas, Terence Blanchard, and Leo Nocentelli receive at WWOZ.

WWOZ awards each *School Groove* band with \$1,000 to help with needs such as musical instruments, travel, or uniforms. Students also share lunch with key staff members where they can learn about careers in the broadcast and recording industry.
