- Daily live concerts & symposiums



We use America's original musical art form to stimulate students' creative self-expression, personal growth and collective engagement. Our tested programs change lives, build communities, and serve as a model for K-12 jazz education. JAZZ HOUSE KiDS serves students from 50 school districts across New Jersey, as well as national and international students. We serve as a gateway to achievement for all students, particularly those in New Jersey's under-resourced communities.

- JAZZ HOUSE KiDS has served 50,000+ young people and presented performances for over half a million music fans
- 100% of students at the JAZZ HOUSE continue on to college and have received more than \$1.5 million in college scholarships
- JAZZ HOUSE KiDS provides tuition assistance support for 40% of its student body, and never turns students away from its door
- Created to bridge the music gap in underserved schools, weekly JAZZ HOUSE KiDS Music Clubs provide middle and high school students with robust jazz education free of charge
