Kayla Andrus and Tyla Keys receive Oscar J. Tolmas Charitable Trust Scholarships

Since 2018, First Tee Greater New Orleans has selected high school seniors who have graduated from the First Tee program for the distinction of receiving Oscar J. Tolmas Scholarships.

The Oscar J. Tolmas Charitable Trust's mission is to spread the legacy and generosity of its namesake, a native of New Orleans who left his full estate in trust in order to support local charities. He was a WWII veteran, lawyer, real estate developer and horse racing enthusiast whose legacy of philanthropy has helped First Tee programs for several years. On August 10th, the Trust continued their support with a \$25,000 grant to be used in 2021 for scholarships for graduating seniors and to cover summer camp fees for students in need.

For the yearly scholarship, students are selected based on exceptional demonstration of First Tee's Nine Core Values – honesty, integrity, respect, responsibility, courtesy, sportsmanship, confidence, judgment and perseverance. This year we were pleased to honor Kayla Andrus and Tyla Keys, who both graduated this spring.

Kayla, who plans to continue her work as a videographer and photographer by studying Digital Filmmaking, has graduated from Mount Carmel Academy and will attend Loyola University New Orleans. Tyla Keys, who is interested in studying psychology and biology, has graduated from Academy of The Sacred Heart and will attend Rhodes College.

A new class of Ace participants begins their certification projects

To complete the final level of the First Tee program, Ace, participants undertake four projects to prepare them for their future.

The first, Enjoy Golf for Life, is a series of skills development and assessments designed to bring their golf game to their own personal best. The second, Plan for Life and Career Possibilities, asks them to think critically about their future in the world of work and take concrete steps towards laying their foundation. In the third, Give Back to the Community, each participant creates and drives their own unique service project. And in the fourth, Explore Educational Opportunities, Ace participants form and take action on plans for their post-high school education.

Each of their projects will be reviewed by an Ace Judging Committee, and those who score a minimum of 80% will be recognized at the national level by the First Tee network.

We are very excited to announce our newest class of Ace participants! Please join us in congratulating them on taking on this new challenge, and wishing them growth and success. We can't wait to see their ideas come to life!
